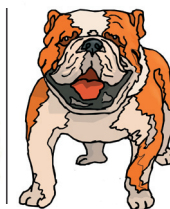

1-Cover Development- Taught by Sheri Hauser, Director Glorybound Publishing. (She's built almost all the covers for the company).	Knowledge related to building a book cover. A cover will be built during the class using InDesign with integration of Photoshop and Illustrator programs.	To follow along: Lap Top with InDesign, Photoshop and Illustrator programs.
2-Business Cards- Taught by Sheri Hauser Director Glorybound Publishing.	Setting up a professional business card. Class includes printing a card and cutting it out. Option for CD of the business card that is developed during the class.	To follow along: Lap Top with Avery Program pre-loaded.
3-Wire Binding a book (A Size) - Taught by Sheri Hauser Director Glorybound Publishing.	Learn the technique of Double-0 Wire binding a book. Perfect for children's books, cook books and short books.	Bring any free pages of a book to bind. No greater than 20 pages. Glorybound Publishing will provide the binder and an option to laminate your cover.

6-Coil Binding of a book. - Taught by Sheri Hauser Director Glorybound Publishing.	Learn simple technique of coil binding books. Good for short books.	Bring any free pages of a book to bind. 8-Registering a Copyright for a book. - Taught by Sheri Hauser Director Glorybound Publishing.	We will walk through registration of a book on-line at the US Government web site.	If you have a book that needs to be registered copyright, you may follow along and register the book. Cost is 30.00 to the web site. (Can save and pay later.)
9-Building a Bar Code - Taught by Sheri Hauser Director Glorybound Publishing.	We will build two different Bar Codes using two software options. ISBN Bar Code and price Bar Code.	Uses Avery software and Wasp Software if you want to load the lap-top and follow along.

The meetings are being held in various locations (usually libraries) in the city with the goal of enabling as many as possible to attend the sessions. It is encouraged to writers and artists to bring their lap-top and appropriate software as recommended for the class. Sessions will last 45 min-70 min. Many have a lab which enables the participants to print off the book, business card, or menu (project) and bind it on site (using Glorybound Publishing equipment).
